In line with its business projects and any new or updated product and service, SUSA looks at these environmental aspects, thus exerting a positive influence on them. Both Environmental Protection and Improvement represent an integral part of the future competitiveness of SUSA's services. For this reason, SUSA focuses on the following general objectives:

- Ongoing respect of rules and regulations in force
- Operative and environmental efficiency of processes
- Ongoing improvement and pollution prevention



For all the above, SUSA's **General Manager** commits himself to playing an active role in promoting and leading all the activities affecting the surrounding environment. The main actions having environmental effects in our company are strictly linked to the transport operations: exhaust emissions, natural resources' consumption, garage waste production and management (though less significantly), natural resources exploitation, noise emissions, waste water, security, outer appearance and a more general support to the needs of the involved Parties.

THE GUIDELINES

- To support an **Environmental Management System** compliant to the UNI EN ISO 14001:15
- To keep constantly monitored the compliance degree of the System to the relevant standards, regulations and requirements signed by SUSA. Any deviation will be handled by means of suitable corrective actions.
- To promote and implement training sessions, about the Environmental Policy adopted, for all the company personnel, thus providing each human resource with the competences considered necessary in order to avoid any kind of environmental impact and to face any occurring environmental emergency

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

- To communicate proactively with any subject outside the company, by means of official statements, web communications and specific financial reports
- To involve the entire Suppliers' network, by promoting and implementing all the processes aimed to a continuous improvement of the environmental performances
- To appoint the **Quality Management Group (AQ)** for the **Environmental Management System Manual** implementation and follow-up
- To set the environmental goals in the Environmental Management Plan and to evaluate the relevant progress status, by means of numerical indicators
- To set a regular review of both the **Environmental Management System** and the **Environmental Management Plan** so to grant suitability and effectiveness and a continuous improvement effort
- To reduce any energy waste (i.e. use of high-performance equipment)
- To make use of reusable materials and equipment and/or having an environmental low impact (i.e. clean energy sources, equipment without contaminating gas)
- To act according to the best technical, logistics and organizational practices aimed to minimize manipulation and transportation of chemical substances, especially in emergency issues (damages, accidental discharges, disposals, etc.)
- To find suitable solutions for the waste treatment, to reduce direct and indirect costs due to a wrong environmental management, to seize the opportunities arising from a correct environmental management
- To evaluate the specific company context and the relevant risks, so to prevent the process deviations, thus reducing the negative results.
- To check the achievement of the previously set overall target
- To define objectives and tools for the following year.

All the personnel, starting with the **General Manager**, and all the providers who cooperate with **SUSA S.p.A.** are responsible of the environmental impact and the implementation of the relevant documentation per business area involved.
